Ruth:

The mother of Obed and great-grandmother of David. A woman of the country of Moab. Ruth married Mahlon, one of the two sons of Elimelech and Naomi. With his wife and sons, Elimelech had migrated to Moab to escape the famine in the land of Israel. When Elimelech and both of his sons died, they left three widows: Naomi, Ruth, and Orpah. When Naomi decided to return home to Bethlehem, Ruth chose to accompany her, saying, "Wherever you go, I will go".

In Bethlehem Ruth was permitted to glean in the field of Boaz, a wealthy kinsman of Elimelech. At Naomi's urging, Ruth asked protection of Boaz as next of kin - a reflection of the Hebrew law of Levirate Marriage. After a nearer kinsman waived his right to buy the family property and provide Elimelech an heir, Boaz married Ruth. Their son, Obed, was considered one of Naomi's family, according to the custom of the day.

Ruth's firm decision - "Your people shall be my people, and your God, my God" - brought a rich reward. She became an ancestor of David and Jesus.
