The Bible is God speaking to us. Paul indicated, "All scripture is given by inspiration of God" (2 Timothy 3:16 NKJV). Peter acknowledged that "holy men of God spoke as they were moved by the Holy Spirit" (2 Peter 1:21). God speaks from His word. Are we listening?

The Bible is a lamp and a light (Psalm 119:105). The Bible can help us better understand life and its difficulties.
