This and That

What would it be like if you awoke one morning and found that, through the night, you had been transformed into a king (or queen)? What if you were transported back in time and found yourself a priest under the Old Testament. It would be awesome to experience this for a little while, wouldn't it? If you were king, what would you rule? If you were priest what would you sacrifice?

If you are a Christian this is really true. However, you didn't just awake in that condition, you were born anew. In Revelation 1:5-6, John writes: "Unto him that loved us, and washed us from our sins in his own blood, And hath made us kings and priests unto God and his Father;" This means we're kings and priests, right? This immediately conjures up 3 questions in my mind.

1. As king, what do I reign over?
2. As priest, what do I offer?
3. Where do I reign and preside?

God's word answers these questions. As King, we are to rule our own body. (Matt. 5:29-30; Romans 6:12-13) As priest, we are to present our bodies a living sacrifice. (Romans 12:1-2) We do these things while living in our body here on earth. (John 2:21; Revelation 5:9-10) Are we ruling, presiding, and sacrificing, as we ought? Remember, we serve the "King of Kings and Lord of Lords." Think about it.

Americans today are encouraged to invest their assets in hope of a greater long-term return. There are many brokers and journals competing to assist you. Each of us *should* take a closer look at our *most valuable* assets and determine to invest.

The Church and Family are two great assets God has given us. These are greater assets than our money and much more worthy of investment. "Christ also loved the church and gave himself for it" Eph. 5:25 "Whoso findeth a wife findeth a good Thing", Proverbs 18:22. "That they may teach the young women... to love their husband", Titus 2:4. "the glory of children are their fathers", Proverbs 17:6. "Children are an heritage of the Lord, the fruit of the womb is his reward", Psalms 127:3. Both Church and Home are designed to nurture life, our greatest asset, and is certainly worth investing our time and energy. God's Word promises an eternal gain when investing in these *heavenly* assets!
