It's that time again! Yep, it's VBS time. We spend 6 months getting ready for it and 6 months getting over it. That's an exaggeration of course, but close. Everybody has been busy ordering supplies, decorating rooms and such. It makes one excited as we see the week approaching. This year's theme is "Rise and Shine for Jesus". With a farm as the backdrop we study lessons that allow us to rise early and shine often for Jesus. Here is a brief look at each lesson:

Rise and Shine for Jesus, *By Being Thankful*. Using the story of the ten lepers of Luke 17, this lesson teaches the importance of being thankful. It also shows how ugly being ungrateful can be.

Rise and Shine for Jesus, *By Caring and Sharing*. Reasons why we should care about those Jesus cares about. Why it is important to share with others. "We must not close our eyes and ears to human tragedy".

Rise and Shine for Jesus, *By Being Honest*. The world, very often, can be dishonest. Other people may not behave in a truthful and honest way, but we can and must do so. Jesus is our example.

Rise and Shine for Jesus, *By Being a Peacemaker*. Our nation has been at war with foreign peoples and in various places for many years. Abraham was a great example of peacemaking, as he negotiated a peace plan for his and Lot's people. We need peace in our homes, communities, and churches.

Rise and Shine for Jesus, *By Overcoming Temptation*. Temptation takes many forms, most especially in television, magazines, the internet, videos, and suggestive songs. We must recognize that temptation can be overcome. This begins with faith in God.
