This and That

Denominationalism within Christianity is a departure from the oneness Jesus set in order prior and subsequent to His resurrection and ascension. The word denomination literally means a division. The divisions of today are based on a departure from the word of God. Each denomination usually has a name that is foreign to the New Testament and has teachings that are additions to or subtractions from the Bible. In John 17th chapter Jesus prayed that all His followers be one. He said, "Neither pray I for these alone, but for them also which shall believe on me through their word; That they all may be one; as thou, Father, art in me, and I in thee, that they also may be one in us: that the world may believe that thou hast sent me." The only way to do this is to get back to the Bible and the Bible alone as our rule of faith and practice.

There was one church established by Jesus. He told Peter He would build His *church*, Matthew 16:18. Since it is His church it is referred to as His body. In Colossians 1:18, Paul said, "He is the head of the body, the church". In Ephesians 4:4, he said "There is one body...". In this one body we now have several items of worship as taught by the New Testament.

Singing: In Ephesians 5:19, Paul said, "Speaking to yourselves in psalms and hymns and spiritual songs, singing and making melody in your heart to the Lord;" In 1 Corinthians 14:15 he said he would do it with understanding.

Prayer: Prayer, as we know it, is communication with God. It is natural that man should want to talk with his creator. 1 Thessalonians 5:17 says to "Pray without ceasing". This indicates the attitude we should have regarding prayer. It should be something that we do on a regular basis, especially in the church services.

Preaching/Teaching: When Paul entered the Jewish synagogues he did so with the intention of teaching. Peter preached on the birthday of the church, Acts 2.

The Lord's Supper: The communion of the fruit of the vine and unleavened bread was instituted by Jesus prior to His arrest in Matthew 26.

Contribution: The treasury is supplied by the church members giving each week as they have been prospered. This is found in 1 Corinthians 16:2. Think about it.
