

Whom do you seek to please? We may spend the greater part of the day trying to please ourselves. Whether it is where we are at, what we are wearing, what we eat, who we are with, etc., we try to please ourselves. We may also use our many talents and resources to try to please a loved one. Paul said "But he that is married careth for the things that are of the world, how he may please his wife", 1 Corinthians 7:33. In the next verse, he also says the wife tries to please her husband. This is only natural and should be thus. However as Christians there is one whom we should strive to please at all times. This is God. In 1 Thessalonians 4:1, Paul says, "Furthermore then we beseech you, brethren, and exhort you by the Lord Jesus, that as ye have received of us how ye ought to walk and to please God, so ye would abound more and more." This means that we should live our lives each day in a manner that pleases God. In Hebrews 11:5 it is said, "By faith Enoch was translated that he should not see death; and was not found, because God had translated him: for before his translation he had this testimony, that he pleased God." Now this doesn't infer that by pleasing God all will be translated, but it does suggest that those who please God will go to be with him when he leaves this world.

We must have faith in order to be pleasing unto God. Hebrews 11:6 says, "But without faith it is impossible to please him: for he that cometh to God must believe that he is, and that he is a rewarder of them that diligently seek him." Since our faith comes by hearing the word of God, Romans 10:17, we should do all that we can to strengthen our faith. Some ways to do this:
