This and That

A man woke up in the night slightly shaking. Thinking he was taking a cold, he got up, took some cold tablets, and went back to bed. The next morning he felt fine. After getting the morning newspaper, he noticed the headline, “Earthquake Shakes City at Night”. What is the moral of the story? We can jump to the wrong conclusions at times.

Can you think of a Biblical example of someone jumping to conclusions? In Mark chapter 6, we find that Jesus had begun to teach, cast out demons, and heal the sick. When his fame was spread abroad, there were many folks who “jumped to conclusions”. Herod thought Jesus was John the Baptist who he had beheaded. Others thought he was Elijah, one of the prophets or as a prophet. What was the reason for jumping to these conclusions? The reasons are varied. Herod had a bad conscience, some misinterpreted Malachi chapter 4, and still others was simply ignorant of the scriptures.

Do we sometimes jump to conclusions? Sure we do. But, how can we be sure to form the right conclusions? The answer lies in our respect for correctness, information, and other people. Do we *really want* to form a correct conclusion? Do we make *every effort* to obtain *all* the information? Do we *react rashly* prior to receiving all the information? Do we give others the *benefit of the doubt* or do we think the worst? Jumping to conclusions can hurt self and others. Think about it.
