This and That

Courage, as used in various settings throughout the Bible, refers to a definite characteristic possessed by Leaders. Courage is defined as Strong, Bold, Alert, Brave, and Stout. The spies sent to gather information about the land of Canaan were told to find courage at this time, Numbers 13:20. Of course, we know that 10 of the 12 failed to reach deep enough to follow through with their mission. Joseph of Arimathea “taking courage went in to Pilate and asked for the body of Jesus”, Mark 15:43 nkj. The Apostle Paul needed courage at times to endure the problems that he faced. On his journey to Rome as a prisoner, certain brethren came to meet Paul and his companions. “When Paul saw them, he thanked God and took courage”.

As we scan the Bible, we realize that, at nearly all times, we are either a possessor of courage or in need of it. When Joshua was to take the leadership of the children of Israel, he was told to *possess courage* and the people were told to *encourage* him, Deuteronomy 1:38, 31:7. Barnabas was given this name by the other apostles because it meant “Son of encouragement”. He must have been an optimistic person who gave others courage. Paul said his Christian actions should be a source of encouragement for those of Laodicea and Colossi, Colossians 2:1-2. My hope is that you possess courage or have been encouraged by this message.
