Doctrine. What is it? Where is it found? Is it important? These questions beg for an answer. Rather than be indifferent to doctrine we should be diligent enough to answer these questions.

First of all, doctrine is defined as *teaching*. That answers the 1st question, what is it? We are taught many things as we grow up and into adulthood. So far as this article is concerned, we are talking of the teachings of Jesus. Mark 4:2 “And he taught them many things by parables, and said unto them in his doctrine...”
