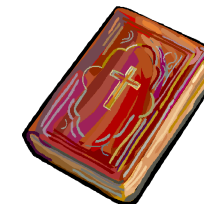

Abraham is a truly great character in the Bible. He is first introduced as 1 of 3 sons of Terah in Genesis 11. He is last mentioned in 1 Peter 3:6 along with Sarah. In between we are introduced to some outstanding qualities that made him great. Consider that Abraham:

Obeyed God-Gen.26: 5	Was Hospitable-Gen. 18:2-8
Valued Peace-Gen 13:8-9	Taught Children- Gen. 18:18-19
Had Integrity-Gen. 14:21-23	Concern for others-Gen. 18:23-33
Faithful Heart- Neh. 9:7-8	Honest and Fair- Gen. 23:7-20
Honored Marriage- Gen. 24:3	Rejoiced in Jesus- John 8:56
Believed God- Romans 4:3	Walked by Faith – Hebrews 11:8-9

Abraham was not perfect, but because of his desire to please God, he was able to accomplish great things. He is called, “A friend of God”, Isaiah 41:8. Heaven is his reward, Matthew 8:11 and Paradise is his namesake, Luke 16:22. Perhaps the greatest tribute to Abraham is the faithfulness of his children, Isaac and Jacob.
