If you compare yourself with someone who is smarter, more talented, or more physically attractive, you look inferior. If you compare yourself with someone who is less intelligent, less talented and less attractive, you feel superior.

If you want to have a true measure of yourself, measure yourself by the true standard: the Word of God.

It is further proof that this amazing world in which we live is intricately designed. And, as we all know, design demands a designer.

Enjoy once again this telling statement from the founding director of NASA's Goddard Institute for Space Studies, Robert Jastrow: "for the scientist who has lived by his faith in the power of reason, the story ends like a bad dream. He has scaled the mountains of ignorance; he is about to conquer the highest peak; as he pulls himself over the final rock, he is greeted by a band of theologians who have been sitting there for centuries."
