Page 95. Page 95. These are familiar words for those of us who attend services at Clay City Church of Christ. Brother Walter Rice frequently begins services with these words and the song, "The Last Mile of the Way". A closer look at some of the song's words reveal great blessings. Seeing Jesus in all his glory, resting in heaven, no parting due to sickness and sighing, are all great blessings to look forward to. However, those blessings are predicated upon completing requirements. *If* I walk in the pathway of duty, *If* I work till the close of the day, I shall see the great King in his beauty when I've gone the last mile of the way. *If* for Christ I proclaim the glad story, *If* I seek for his sheep gone astray, I am sure He will show me His glory when I've gone the last mile of the way.

The word *if* means *in the event that* or *on the condition that*. There are conditions acknowledged by all who know and sing this beautiful old hymn. I must walk in the pathway of duty. Solomon said the whole duty of man is to fear God and keep his commandments, Ecclesiastes 12:13. I must work till the close of the day.
