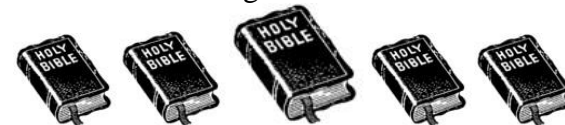

The Duties of Parents to Their Children

No one who believes the Bible will deny that it is the duty of parents to teach their children the Word of God. They should surround their children with the ennobling and uplifting influences of a well-regulated Christian home.

God required the Jews to teach their children His law. "And that thou mayest tell in the ears of thy son, and of thy son's son, what things I have wrought upon Egypt, and my signs which I have done among them; that ye may know how that I am the Lord" (Exodus 10:2). "And it shall come to pass, when your children shall say unto you, 'What mean ye by this service?' That ye shall say, It is the sacrifice of the Lord's Passover, who passed over the houses of the children of Israel in Egypt, when He smote the Egyptians, and delivered our houses" (12:26-27). "And thou shalt teach them diligently unto thy children, and shalt talk of them when thou sittest in thy house, and when thou walkest by the way, and when thou liest down, and when thou risest up" (Deuteronomy 6:7). "Therefore shall ye lay up these my words in your heart and in your soul, and bind them for a sign upon your hand, that they may be as frontlets between your eyes" (11:18).

Thus it is seen that parents should treasure the Word of God in their hearts in order that they might be able to teach it to their children. God has not delegated this duty to others.

Parents who neglect to chasten, reprove and correct their children do so at their own peril and at the destruction of their children. "Like as a father pitieth his children, so the Lord pitieth them that fear Him" (Psalm 103:13). "Whom the Lord loveth He correcteth; even as a father the son in whom he delighteth" (Proverbs 3:12). "A good man leaveth an inheritance to his children's children....He that spareth his rod hateth his son; but he that loveth him chasteneth him betimes" (13:22-24). "Train up a child in the way he should go:and when he is old he will not depart from it....Foolishness is bound up in the heart of a child; but the rod of correction shall drive it far from him" (22:6,15). "And, ye fathers provoke not your children to wrath: but bring them up in the nurture and admonition of the Lord" (Ephesians 6:4).
