How to reach others and achieve unity? Try James' approach: "But the wisdom that is from above is first pure, then peaceable, gentle, and easy to be intreated, full of mercy and good fruits, without partiality, and without hypocrisy." James 3:17

The Holy Spirit, through James, is making the case for unity through a bridling of the *human* tongue. Letting God do the talking for us. Accepting what *He* says and following through with what *He* requires. Problem is, most of us find this difficult to accept. Seems as though we want to put our 2 cents worth in. However, 2¢ can be very costly in the end. God's formula is:

- Pure Wisdom first. The Bible must be placed first and accepted by all of us as the standard of righteousness.
- Peace should be sought based upon what the Bible says.
- We should always be gentle in our dealing with others when presenting the doctrine of Christ.
- Easy to be intreated means that we find it easy to obey what the Lord says in his word and we are easily approachable.
- The outgrowth of our obedience to the word is a life filled with kindness and goodwill towards others, without being partial or hypocritical.

By following this example we are sure to have greater success in reaching others.
