This and That

In Acts the 7th chapter we read of the defense given by Stephen which culminated in his stoning and death. This caused the disciples to scatter into other provinces and towns to preach the gospel. Some, such as Phillip, went south to preach in the regions of Samaria. Still others went north into Phenice, Cyprus and eventually preached in Antioch. This was a fulfillment of Jesus prophecy of Acts chapter 1, verse 8 that they would be his witnesses unto "the uttermost part of the earth". Now when the Jerusalem church heard of the preaching occurring in the North and West, (a great number believed and turned to the Lord), they sent Barnabas to this area so that he could help in this field of work. This is recorded in Acts chapter 11. It is said of Barnabas (when he came to Antioch,) "Who, when he came, and had seen the grace of God, was glad, and exhorted them all, that with purpose of heart they would cleave unto the Lord."

The fruit of *our* labors here should be the salvation of souls. This should make us labor with more diligence and the realization of this goal should make us glad. An item I want to note here is that Barnabas exhorted the people that "with purpose of heart they should *cleave* unto the Lord." There should be a purpose and goal associated with our relationship to the Lord. There is but little doubt that we would work harder, love greater, and sacrifice more if we but realized on a daily basis that our goal is to make heaven our home. We also have much work to do if we are to build up the kingdom of God upon earth and become more effective in soul winning. Remember that someone cared enough about you to keep house for the Lord and evangelize the gospel in your direction. Another item of note in Acts 11 is that Barnabas exhorted the brethren to "cleave" unto the Lord. The thought is that they should remain still, tarry with, and hold fast to the Lord. Folks we need to do that today. We need to follow closely in the footsteps of Jesus and keep our eyes focused upon him at all times. This will keep us in line with our purpose and goal of heaven.
