This and That

The song *öLily of the Valleyö*, begins by saying, *I have found a friend in Jesus, He's everything to me.* And it is true that Jesus is everything to the Christian. Paul says it best when he states that God *ó* "*hath put all things under his feet, and gave him to be the head over all things to the church, 23. Which is his body, the fulness of him that filleth all in all.*", Ephesians 1:22-23. This was prophesied many years ago by the prophet Isaiah. In chapter 9 and verse 6 of his book, Isaiah says, "*For unto us a child is born, unto us a son is given: and the government shall be upon his shoulder: and his name shall be called Wonderful, Counseller, The mighty God, the everlasting Father, The Prince of Peace.*"

1. Jesus is wonderful. The word wonderful comes from a Hebrew word that means marvelous and extraordinary. Jesus is not *ö*just another prophet*ö*. He was not an ordinary person. He was and is the blessed one of God.
2. Jesus is our counselor. This means that He is our advisor and is thus to be consulted. If there are any questions that we may have, Jesus has the answers.
3. Jesus is the mighty God. When God created the heavens and the earth, Jesus was part of that Godhead. The three, God, Christ, and the Holy Spirit all participated in the creation. And so they do today in the redemption and salvation of mankind.
4. Jesus is the everlasting Father. When the apostles were desirous to see the Father, Jesus addressed Phillip's inquiry by saying, *öhave I been so long time with you, and yet hast thou not known me, Philip? he that hath seen me hath seen the Father; and how sayest thou then, Shew us the Father?*" John 14:9.
5. Jesus is the Prince of Peace. The word Prince means leader. The word peace refers not only to quiet and tranquility, but also to completeness in number, soundness in body, and safety in our overall health and welfare.

Jesus is truly everything to us. We should be a Christian and live the type of life that He approves of. By doing this we can be assured that He is our extraordinary counselor that represents God to us and brings everlasting peace from the Father. Think about it.
