This and That

The Christian life is one of faith and trust. Because the world can be a difficult place to live unless one has direction and guidance, a relationship with Jesus is necessary. His word is given to provide the instructions for such a relationship. Ultimately a trusting faith is required in order to realize the goals desired. Let so notice the following facts about the Christian life:

The Christian is justified by faith. In Romans 5:1-2 Paul says, õTherefore being justified by faith, we have peace with God through our Lord Jesus Christ: By whom also we have access by faith into this grace wherein we stand, and rejoice in hope of the glory of Godö. Faith was the justifier of such great men as Abraham and Noah. Their faith produced within them an obedient spirit. Because of their faith in Godøs promises they received great blessings. We must begin with faith also. Without faith we cannot please God. Therefore we should become acquainted with His word which produces faith.

The Christian walks by faith and lives by faith. This means their everyday life is controlled by what God teaches. 2 Corinthians 5:7 states that õWe walk by faith, not by sightö. We believe God speaks the truth in the Bible and are glad to use its teachings to make everyday life decisions. Hebrews 10:38 declares that õthe just shall live by faithö. It is wonderful to know a standard exists that, if followed, will produce good results every time.

According to 1 Peter 1:9, the Christian is õkept by the power of God through faith unto salvation ready to be revealed in the last timeö. Godøs power to keep us from falling and to preserve us unto the day of salvation is invoked through our faith. When we live a faithful life, (faithful to what the Bible says), we are trusting our current and future life in safe keeping to God. We know He has been faithful to His promises and therefore we trust Him to continue faithfully what He has started in Jesus Christ.

Some people trust in wealth and social status to provide the security they desperately need and desire. Others just float along, taking what life offers without the pursuit or thought of a grander purpose. Christians are secure in the fact that they have found truth and know who they are, where they came from, and where they are going. We believe God. We believe in Jesus Christ. We love the church. Our desire is to make heaven our home through faith and obedience. Think about it.
