## This and That

According to God's word there will be a general resurrection of both the bad and good which will be followed by a judgment. There are several facts that I would like for us to consider.

You and I will participate in the resurrection and judgment. Jesus said, "Marvel not at this: for the hour is coming, in the which all that are in the graves shall hear his voice, 29. And shall come forth; they that have done good, unto the resurrection of life; and they that have done evil, unto the resurrection of damnation," John 5:28-29.

Jesus Christ will be the Judge. Paul informed the Athenians in Acts 17:31, "Because he hath appointed a day, in the which he will judge the world in righteousness by that man whom he hath ordained; whereof he hath given assurance unto all men, in that he hath raised him from the dead."
